Official School Attire

Monday; and first school day of the week.

Students are to wear PE attire throughout the day.



11.2.2 School Uniform

- a) wear the prescribed school uniform and modification to the uniform is not allowed.
- b) The school uniform comprises:
 - (i) navy blue shorts;
 - (ii) white shirt with blue school badge embroidered on the left-hand pocket while the nametag must be on the right at the same level as the badge; and
 - (iii) plain white shoes with laces and plain white socks which cover about 4 centimeters above the ankle
- c) wear the uniform on the first day of every school week.
- d) always wear his uniform with pride and keep it clean and tidy at all times.




Example of acceptable hair style

11.3 LOVE FOR SELF

- 11.3.1 Personal Grooming
- a) Face is to be clean-shaven at all times.
- b) No facial hair is allowed.
- c) Hair must be short and tidy.
- d) Fringe must NOT touch eyebrows.
- e) Hair must not touch the ear or collar of the shirt.
- f) Hair must not be dyed or highlighted.
- g) Outlandish hairstyles are not allowed, e.g. undercut or Mohawk.
- h) Fingernails must be short and clean.
- i) Ornaments and jewellery are not allowed.
- j) Items such as charms, amulets and other artefacts must not be worn in a way that will compromise the safety of the Saint.
